Training on South-South Triangular Cooperation in Implementing the 2030 Agenda

Training on “South-South & Triangular Cooperation in Implementing the 2030 Agenda” was held in IARTC between 27th-28th April 2017 to provide knowledge about their institutions to the participants and to ensure the participants have a clear understanding of 2030 Sustainable Development Agenda. Coordinators from



GDAR, directors, deputy directors and technical personal from different Institutes working on the same subjects with SS&TC, 21 participants in total participated in the training.

On the first day, understanding SS&TC in the context of Agenda 2030 and internalizing approaches; on the second day, building practical SS&TC program-

mes in support of national priorities were focused in the training program.

By the end of the course, participants were able to understand the foundations and the modalities of the SS & TC approach in the context of the 2030 Agenda and were familiar with the most recent tools and methods in the area of SS & TC.



Training on Water Use Efficiency Evaluation in Irrigated Lands and Soil Moisture Sensors Utilization, Installation and Calibration

“Training on Water Use Efficiency Evaluation in Irrigated Lands and Soil Moisture Sensors Utilization, Installation and Calibration” in the scope of national project “Determination of technical and economic performance of drip irrigation systems used in Turkey” was held in IARTC between 6-11 March 2017 with the participation of 36 researchers from the project and experts working on agricultural irrigation.

During training conducted to determine the performance of drip irrigation system, retired lecturer Prof. Dr. Rıza Kanber from Çukurova University instructed lectures on evalu-



ation of drip irrigation systems, general principles and calculation methods. Besides, flow pressure measurement in drip irrigation system and infiltration test were demonstrated in the field. Experts from METOS Informatics and Agriculture Technologies Company briefed the participants on soil moisture sensors and calibration on 11th March 2017.



Olive Growing and Pruning Training

“Olive Growing and Pruning Training” organized by General Directorate of Vegetative Production (BÜGEM) was held in IARTC between 20th February- 2nd March 2017. 263 technical personnel from Provincial and District Directorates of Ministry of Food Agriculture and Livestock of the regions made of olive cultivation participated in the training in three groups .

Experts from Bornova Olive Research Institute instructed lectures on olive growing, variety recognition on the olive, pollination, fertilization, diseases and pests, and pruning. Pruning was demonstrated to the participants in olive field.
